Federal and State Environmental Officials to Attend "Floating" Media Conference on Historic Piscataqua Gundalow

Dover, NH – The Corporate Wetlands Restoration Partnership (CWRP) will hold a "floating" media conference on **Tuesday, November 9, 2004 at 10 a.m.** to discuss the removal of the Bellamy Mills Dam and highlight the project's environmental benefits as well as the public/private partnership that helped make it possible. The media conference will take place on the historic Piscataqua Gundalow, which will be moored in the Bellamy River.
