



CORPORATE WETLANDS RESTORATION PARTNERSHIP FACT SHEET

The goal of the Corporate Wetlands Restoration Partnership is to facilitate corporate interest, involvement and support for the state's aquatic resources.

- Funds collected by CWRP are used to restore coastal and freshwater wetlands and rivers degraded by human activities such as, fill, pollution, or changes in water flow.
- The program has been adopted by the federal government as a national initiative and New Hampshire is the 5th New England state to join the partnership.
- The voluntary partnership combines corporate contributions with federal and state funds to undertake restoration. On average, every \$1 of corporate contributions will bring up to \$3 in matching federal monies.
