



PVD/T. F. Green Airport Supplemental Scoping Meeting

FEBRUARY 8, 2005

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is restarting the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) process for the T.F. Green Airport Improvement Projects. A public meeting will be held to develop a supplemental scope of technical analysis for the EIS.

What is Scoping?

Scoping is used to determine the range of alternatives, issues, and impacts that the EIS will address. Scoping provides the public with the opportunity to contribute to the technical direction and analysis of the EIS and to contribute information that could be relevant to evaluation of the impacts of the proposed action.

Why is there Supplemental Scoping?

Additional or supplemental scoping is being held for this project because the scope and alternatives for the project have changed.
